**WOOSTER BEGINS NORTH COAST TITLE DEFENSE WITH VICTORY;
SCOTS TIED WITH HIRAM, KENYON IN EARLY GOING**

December 4, 2000

CLEVELAND -- Defending North Coast Athletic Conference champion Wooster (1-0, 5-0) travels to Oberlin (0-1, 2-3) on Wednesday to highlight this week's schedule. The Scots defeated the Yeomen twice during the 1999-00 regular season on their way to their sixth NCAC title. Wooster opened its 2000-01 conference campaign with a 75-59 defeat of Earlham (1-1, 4-1) on Dec. 2. Junior point guard **Antwyan Reynolds (Mansfield, OH/ Mansfield Senior)** led the Scots with 14 points, six rebounds, four assists and four steals.

Wooster joins Hiram (1-0, 1-3) and Kenyon (1-0, 3-2) for a tie for first in the conference; each school having won its lone NCAC contest. The Terriers won over Denison (1-1, 1-4) while the Lords defeated Allegheny (0-1, 1-5). Wittenberg (0-0, 4-0) and Ohio Wesleyan (0-0, 0-6) are the last teams to join in conference play when they tip off on Wednesday. Allegheny will host Hiram in the other conference contest that day. NCAC games on tap for Saturday are Earlham at Kenyon, Hiram at Wittenberg and Oberlin at Ohio Wesleyan. Wabash (0-1, 0-5) hosts its own Pete Thorn Classic and will return to conference play on Dec. 16 when they travel to Denison.

**KNIGHT, POLLOCK NAMED
NCAC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**

CLEVELAND -- Oberlin senior **James Knight (Chicago, IL/ Brother Rice)** and Allegheny senior **Stephanie Pollock (Cleveland, OH/St. Joseph's Academy)** have been named men's and women's basketball "Players of the Week" in the North Coast Athletic Conference.

Knight, a senior guard, totaled 69 points and 25 rebounds last week as the Yeomen split a pair of contests. He had a career-high 43 points to go with 11 rebounds in Oberlin's conference-opening overtime loss to Denison, then followed that up with 26 points and 14 rebounds in an 80-68 victory against Lake Erie on Dec. 2. He shot 26-for-52 (.500) from the field, including 8-for-13 (.615) shooting from long range.

Pollock, a senior forward, scored 28 points, and added 25 rebounds to lead the Gators to two NCAC wins last week. She contributed 19 points and nine rebounds in a 76-72 defeat of Oberlin, then added 13 points and 13 rebounds in a 73-62 victory over Kenyon. She has double-doubles in three of the Gators' six games this season.

**OHIO WESLEYAN TAKES ON KENYON IN KEY NORTH COAST;
CLASH; TIED WITH THREE OTHERS FOR EARLY NCAC LEAD**

CLEVELAND -- Defending North Coast Athletic Conference regular-season champion Ohio Wesleyan (1-0, 3-1) hosts defending NCAC tournament champion Kenyon (0-2, 3-2) on Wednesday to highlight this week's schedule. The Bishops and Ladies split a pair of games during the 1999-00 regular season, with each team winning at home. Kenyon dropped its first two conference games to Denison (2-0, 5-2) on Nov. 29, and to Allegheny (2-0, 6-1) on Dec. 2. OWU opened with a 76-61 defeat of Wooster on Nov. 29.

In addition to Ohio Wesleyan, Allegheny, Denison and Wittenberg (1-0, 4-1) all enter the week undefeated in conference play. The Big Red will put their perfect NCAC mark on the line on Tuesday when they travel to Wooster (0-2, 1-3), while Allegheny will travel to Hiram (0-1, 1-3) on Wednesday. The only other conference contest slated for the coming week will be when Oberlin (0-1, 1-6) plays host to the Tigers. Earlham (1-1, 2-3) won't see NCAC action again until January.

SWIM SCENE: The Allegheny teams competed at the Eastern Michigan Invitational. The men's squad placed fifth of seven teams with 420.5 points while the women (459.5 points) were third of eight ... Hiram competed in a dual meet at Wilmington. The men's squad won, 95-84, as freshman **Jason Groselle (Hiram, OH/Crestwood)** won three events: the 100-meter freestyle, the 100-meter breaststroke and the 200-meter freestyle. Senior **Matt Davis (Stow, OH/Stow-Monroe Falls)** won the 50-meter freestyle for the Terriers and swam the lead leg on the winning 200-meter freestyle relay ... The Hiram women lost to Wilmington, 113-51. Freshman **Elizabeth Rini (Cleveland Heights, OH/Beaumont)** won the 100-meter breaststroke and anchored the winning 200-meter freestyle relay ... Ohio Wesleyan and Wabash competed at the DePauw Invitational. The OWU men placed fourth of nine with 292 points and the Little Giants were second with 784. The Bishop women finished fourth (471.5 points) in the eight-team women's field ... Wabash freshman **Craig Haupert (Cedar Lake, IN/Lowell)** met the NCAA "B" qualifying standard in the 100-yard breaststroke with a time of 58.19 ... Ohio Wesleyan freshman **Joseph Lankford (Houston, TX/Jones)** met the provisional qualifying standard in the 100-yard butterfly (51.91) and broke OWU's school mark in the 100-yard backstroke (53.31). He placed second in both events and was fifth in the 200 backstroke ... On the women's side, Bishop junior **Susan Patterson (Pickerington, OH/Pickerington)** won the 100-yard butterfly (1:01.83), was third in the 200 butterfly and fourth in the 100 breaststroke.
