**WOOSTER AND WITTENBERG SET TO MEET SATURDAY;
SCOTS AND TIGER DUELING FOR POSSESSION OF FIRST**

CLEVELAND -- Wooster (6-0, 14-1) and Wittenberg (6-0, 11-3), fierce rivals in the race for the North Coast Championship cozily share first place in the standings. That will change as both teams can look forward to a tough week. On Wednesday, the Fighting Scots and Tigers each host one of the two teams locked in a tie for third place. Wabash (5-1, 11-3) travels to Wittenberg, while Ohio Wesleyan (5-1, 9-6), heads to Wooster. The Little Giants split a pair of games with the Tigers during the 2001-02 season, with each team winning at home. The Scots swept the Bishops in two meetings last winter. As if strong midweek challenges weren't enough, Wooster and Wittenberg will play each other on Saturday. The Tigers topped the Scots three times last year, twice during the regular season and again in the championship game of the NCAC Tournament.

Rounding out Wednesday's schedule, Denison (1-5, 3-11) is at Oberlin (0-6, 0-14), Earlham (2-4, 7-8) is at Kenyon (1-5, 1-13) and Hiram (2-4, 4-11) is at Allegheny (2-4, 6-9). Hiram hosts Oberlin for "Hula Night" to highlight the remainder of Saturday's schedule, bringing Terrier and Yeomen fans a rare ray of sunshine during the gloomy days of January. Also on Saturday, Denison, Wabash and Earlham welcome Allegheny, Kenyon and Ohio Wesleyan, respectively. Complete basketball statistics are available on the NCAC website at www.northcoast.org.

KERSTEN, CHAPPELL NAMED NCAC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

CLEVELAND -- Hiram's **Matt Kersten (Akron, OH/Garfield)** and Earlham's **Lindsey Chappell (Highland, IN/Highland)** have been named men's and women's basketball "Players of the Week" in the North Coast Athletic Conference.

Kersten, a 6-1, senior guard, scored 46 in two Terrier games last week, including a season-high 25 in a 101-91 win over Kenyon. His efforts fueled Hiram's largest scoring spree since a 102-63 win over Temple Baptist (TN) on Dec. 30, 1998. Kersten was 14-for-25 from the floor and combined for 11 three-pointers last week, giving him 157 in his career. He also contributed five assists and six steals over the two games.

Chappell, a 5-10, junior forward, led all scorers with 22 points in the Quakers' 10-point loss to first-place Wittenberg, and pulled down a game high nine rebounds and added four blocks. Chappell added 29 and 12 rebounds in a defeat of Heidelberg earlier in the week. For the week, she averaged 25.5 points and 10.5 rebounds, and had her seventh double-double in 11 games this year.

**WITTENBERG CONTINUES TO ROLL IN NCAC PLAY;
TIGERS HOST KENYON AND WOOSTER**

CLEVELAND -- Wittenberg (6-0, 11-4) stands alone atop the standings as the only team undefeated in conference play. In the coming week, the Tigers' perfect mark will be tested twice at home. Wednesday, they host Kenyon (3-3, 8-6), which is tied for fourth, and seventh-place Wooster (3-4, 8-6). Wittenberg swept both the Ladies and the Fighting Scots during the 2001-02 regular season. Last week, Wittenberg senior **Kate Rolf (Fort Wayne, IN/Carroll)** became the sixth player in school history to score 1,000 points in her career when she notched 12 in a victory over third-place Earlham (4-2, 9-4). In addition to Wittenberg, Kenyon and Ohio Wesleyan (5-2, 9-6) each won twice last week.
