**WITTENBERG BEGINS NORTH COAST TITLE DEFENSE NEXT WEEK;
DENISON AND WOOSTER SLATED TO OPEN 2002-03 SEASON**

CLEVELAND -- The 2002-03 North Coast schedule tips off next week, with one game set for Wednesday. Wooster (0-0, 3-0) officially kicks off the league schedule when it welcomes Denison (0-0, 1-2). The Fighting Scots defeated the Big Red, 83-71, in the only meeting between the two teams during the 2001-02 season.

With five games on tap for Saturday, Nov. 7, all 10 teams will have opened the conference portion of their schedules. Allegheny (0-0, 1-1) travels to Wittenberg (0-0, 1-1), Denison visits Wabash (0-0, 2-1) and Earlham (0-0, 2-1) heads to Oberlin (0-0, 0-3), while Hiram (0-0, 1-1) and Kenyon (0-0, 0-2) host Ohio Wesleyan (0-0, 2-0) and Wooster, respectively.

2002 NCAC regular season and tournament champion Wittenberg was tabbed as the preseason favorites in voting by coaches and media earlier this fall. Wooster was second in both polls, followed by Wabash in third, Ohio Wesleyan in fourth and Allegheny in fifth.

**DESJEAN, CHAPPELL NAMED NCAC
PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**

CLEVELAND -- Wabash's **Joe DesJean (Indianapolis, IN/Perry Meridian)** and Earlham's **Lindsey Chappell (Highland, IN/Highland)** have been named men's and women's basketball "Players of the Week" in the North Coast Athletic Conference.

DesJean, a 6-6, senior forward, scored 65 points to lead the Little Giants to a 2-1 week. He netted 34 points, six rebounds and three blocks in a loss to Illinois Wesleyan after tallying 17 points and eight boards in a win against Purdue-Calumet. He finished the week with 14 points and four boards in Wabash's win over Franklin. DesJean leads the conference with 21.7 points per game.

Chappell, a 5-10, junior forward, tallied double digits in all three of the Quakers' games and recorded two double-doubles. In a win over Salem she scored 16 points and pulled down nine rebounds. In Earlham's loss to Centre, she totalled 15 points and 11 boards. In the win over Hanover, she picked up 17 points and rebounds.
